

Biography

Jaimie van Sikkelerus, born on the sunny island of Curaçao, had a motorcycle waiting for him from the moment he was born. His father passed on his passion for motocross early, and as a toddler, Jaimie often rode on a quad with his dad. At the age of three, his family moved back to the Netherlands, where he competed in his first motocross race at just five years old. His talent was visible: "I learned to ride a motorcycle before I could even ride a bicycle—that was my foundation."

It quickly became serious. At eight years old, he achieved a dutch high athlete status and trained daily after school. By the age of ten, he was racing internationally, and won the MX California State winter series title. Injuries, such as a torn liver and broken spine, couldn't hold him back. "When will I be fit enough to ride again?" was always his first question to the doctors. At thirteen years old he switched to Supermoto, where he won every dutch championship race in his debut season.

With great determination, Jaimie competed on international level. European championships and World championships and represented the Netherlands in the Supermoto of Nations-

World Championship as the youngest competitor ever. In 2014 he made the transition to road racing through the European Junior Cup, finishing in the top 10 in his first season.

Three years in Supersport 600 World championships followed, including challenging periods and multiple knee surgeries. In 2020, major operations were necessary to rotate both of his lowerlegs by 15 degrees to reduce the pressure on his knees while racing.

Two seasons later, Jaimie received the unexpected news of an aggressive form of cancer found beneath his chest.

Despite this, he refused to let the illness take his sport away from him and delayed surgery until he finished his final race that season. With this mental resilience, he closed the season with seven podium finishes, including a victory in the highly competitive British Supersport 600—a feat no Dutch rider had ever achieved. After a tough operation and recovery, he returned to the track stronger than ever.

In 2024, Jaimie earned the opportunity to compete in the elite Superbike class and became the first Dutch rider to spend a full season in this category. Despite undergoing two major knee operations again, his determination remains unaffected: "In 2025, I'll give it my all once again."



Then and Now

Motorcross

Jaimie learned to ride a motorcycle before he could ride a bicycle without training wheels. By the age of eight, he had already achieved a special dutch high athlete status, trained after school, and secured top-3 finishes in the national class. From the age of ten, he competed in European championships and became the MX California State winter series Champion USA.

Supermoto

In his first year of Supermoto,
Jaimie won every Dutch race.
He quickly made a transition
to the German championship,
where he immediately competed for the title. For three consecutive years, including European championships he also
represented the Netherlands
in the Supermoto of Nations as
the youngest participant ever,
achieving impressive results.

Road Racing

Jaimie began racing in 2013 and quickly secured a top-10 finish in the European Junior Cup. In 2016, he placed third in the Dutch championship on his first year of Supersport 600cc, what followed was one season European and 3 years world championships. After successful leg surgeries in 2020, he achieved a podium finish in his 2021 rookie year in the BSB Supersport category.


